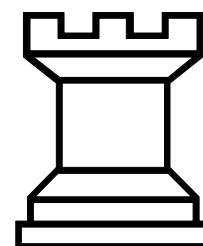

Students 15 or younger may join for \$22 (online magazine) or \$30 (includes 6 issues of *Chess Life*). Students 16 and older may join for \$26 (online magazine) or \$35 (includes 12 issues of *Chess Life*).
